The manuscript, “Collective Bargaining Rights, Policing, and Civilian Deaths,” co-authored with Jamein Cunningham and Donna Feir was completed without any explicit financial support from any party. All of the research therein was conducted as part of my regular appointment at the University of Victoria.

I have received no meaningful financial support from any interested party. The vast majority of my research funding over the window has come from the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada and Mitacs.

With respect to relevant organizations, in the broadest sense of the term, I have been an active volunteer in the labour movement.
