Our Index

Digital pedagogies have become increasingly popular among economic educators. These pedagogies are often found in peer reviewed academic publications. The publication typically includes a print as well as an online component. The print component is easily archived in journal databases that provide full-text access. However, the online materials are often inaccessible through these databases. Our resource aims to provide a remedy to this conundrum by creating an index of websites which will make the digital component of these articles more easily accessible.

We have identified articles that have been published in peer-reviewed academic journals. These journals typically have an author agreement whereby the author promises to maintain the website after the publication for a set period of time. Some of the published papers have websites which have become inactive, other websites are still active while gaining in popularity. Our index provides a curated listing of these active websites.

We invite you to experiment with the multimedia resources during the conference by exploring the hyperlinks embedded in our website. We welcome your feedback for improving this resource for economic educators.
