





What is Dumping?

"A situation of international price discrimination, where the price of a product when sold in the importing country is less than the price of that product in the market of the exporting country." (WTO, 2018)









DC's Policy Options to LDC Dumping



- ❖ Social Welfare of the DC is higher under Anti-dumping Duty
- * AD Duty also enhances Global Welfare

Conclusion

- ❖ It is profitable for an LDC firm to dump its low-quality product in DC market.
- Although dumping is profitable to the LDC exporter, the overall welfare of the LDC decreases when its exporting firm is charged with an AD duty.
- ❖ It is welfare improving for LDC government to restraint its exporting firm not to dump but to negotiate or accept a price undertaking (PU).
- Anti-dumping action against LDC dumping firm is welfare improving both to DC and the world.
